NAAC is a not-for-profit dedicated to connecting artists of all ages with the community at large and fostering creativity in all areas of life. **NAAC** accomplishes the by educating, informing, and inspiring the community through programs and events that encourages appreciation, participation and support of the arts.

NAAC runs the *Old Court House Arts Center* in Woodstock, a community gallery which works with local and national artists to bring new shows monthly to the McHenry county area. 2015 will be the 25th Anniversary of the Art Center and NAAC is busy adding a new gallery to bring in even more events and provide even more opportunities for local artists to display their work.

At the Old Court House Arts Center, NAAC runs several of its own shows as well. Our nationally recognized art exhibition *Women's Works*, celebrating women's creativity, is held each Mach & April. The 2014 show brought together over 120 works from across N. America and Europe. *Little Women's Works* is a show for local girls ages 6-17 and has become a local favorite among many art educators and young artists.

In August and September, **NAAC** holds its second international exhibition, *Real People*, dedicated to portraits and figurative artwork. Held in conjunction with two other art shows, the triple show is always a visual treat.
